A Distinguished Career

She began her career at WellLife Network (formerly PSCH) in 1987 as a Direct Care Counselor. As a dedicated and hard working staff member, she was promoted to Case Manager Supervisor, Site Coordinator, Program Director, Assistant, Deputy and then Acting Director. In 2014 Crystal became Director of Mental Health Residential Services.

In addition to our residential services, Ms. John oversees the peer-run Bridger program, Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) and is leading WellLife Network with cutting-edge initiatives such as Respite Crisis Beds, mixed-use housing and family-uniting strategies.

Ms. John is an alumna of Fordham University where she earned her MSW Degree. She also attended Metropolitan College, earning a Bachelors degree in human services.
